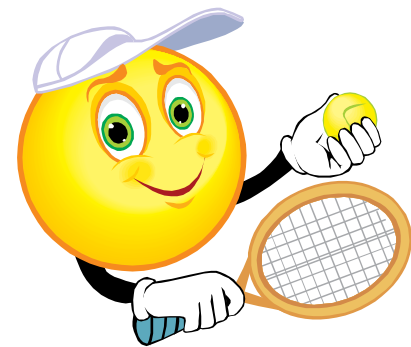


COMMUNITY NEWS
