Year 4/5

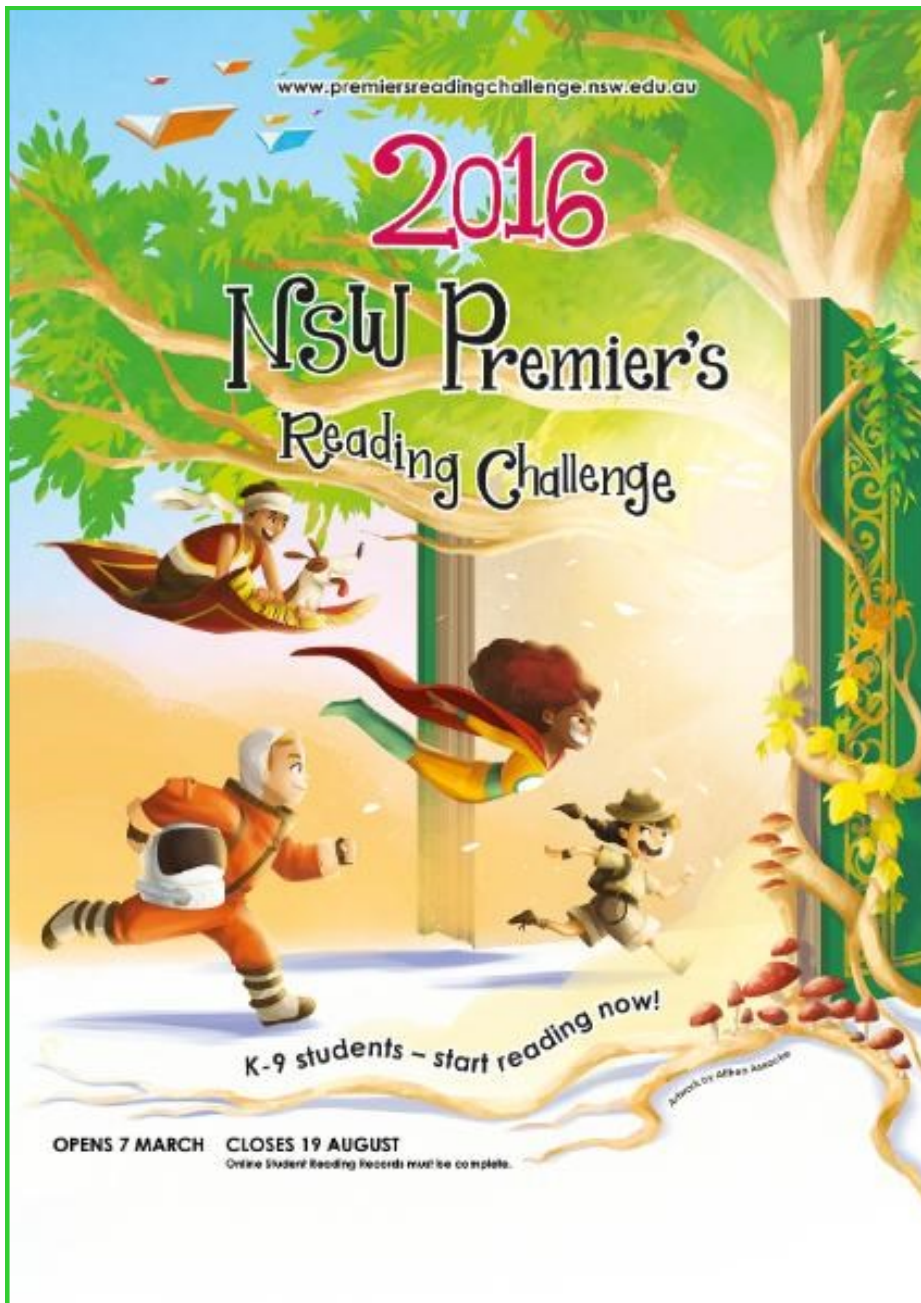

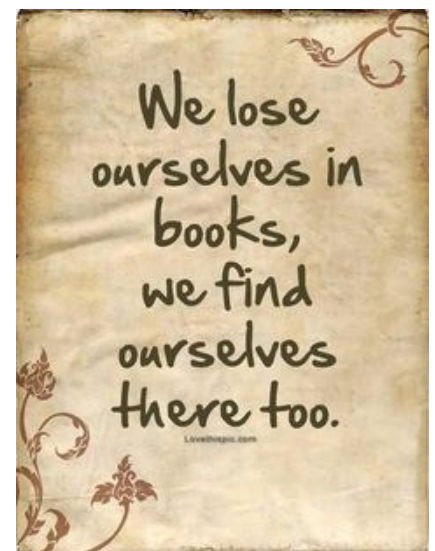
Year 5/6

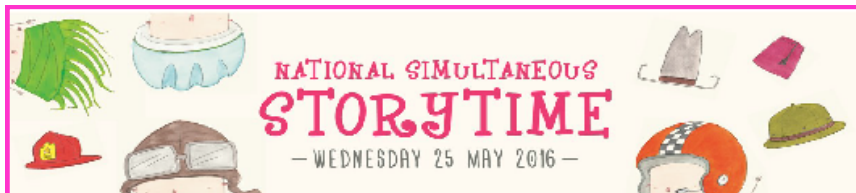
