Sport becomes a little quieter for the next few weeks as the major events of swimming, athletics and cross country are completed. The focus will now be on AFL and Netball.



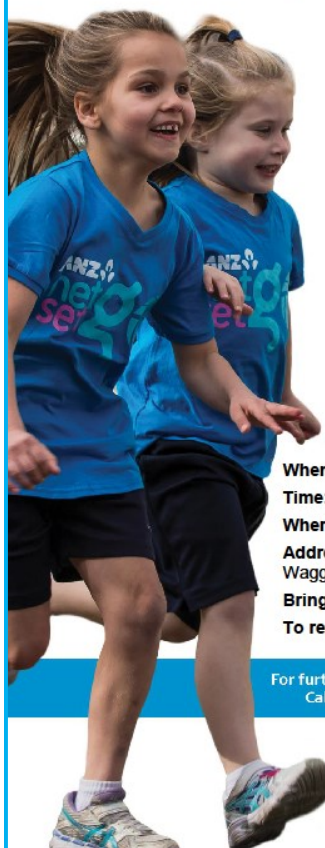
Tony Lockett Shield: This event takes place on Thursday 30th June at Holbrook. All participating students have received a permission note; please return to office as soon as possible.
