Thank you to all the parents who have made a time to chat with me this week. If you are unable to attend, please contact me and I will arrange a more suitable time.

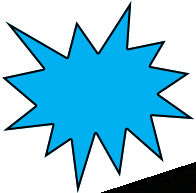
Good luck to Isabel and Genevieve who are attending the Riverina Multicultural Perspectives speech competition today at Thurgoona Public School.

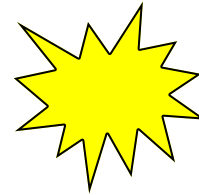
The students who have a 100% homework return rate will be rewarded with a hot chip lunch tomorrow.

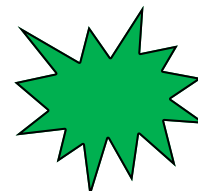


The children enjoyed a beautiful lunch and dressing up in footy colours to support Taylor Clark last Friday.

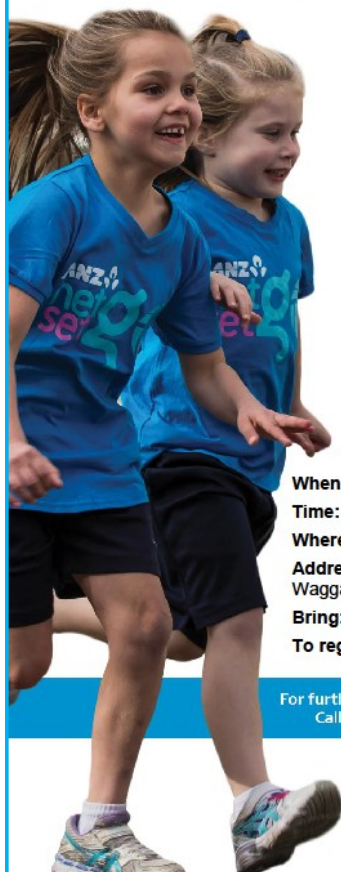
