

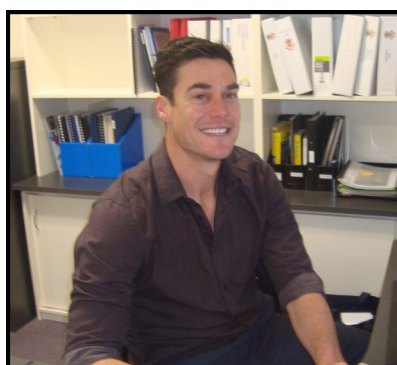

* Permission notes for the eisteddfod went out today. Please return these ASAP!



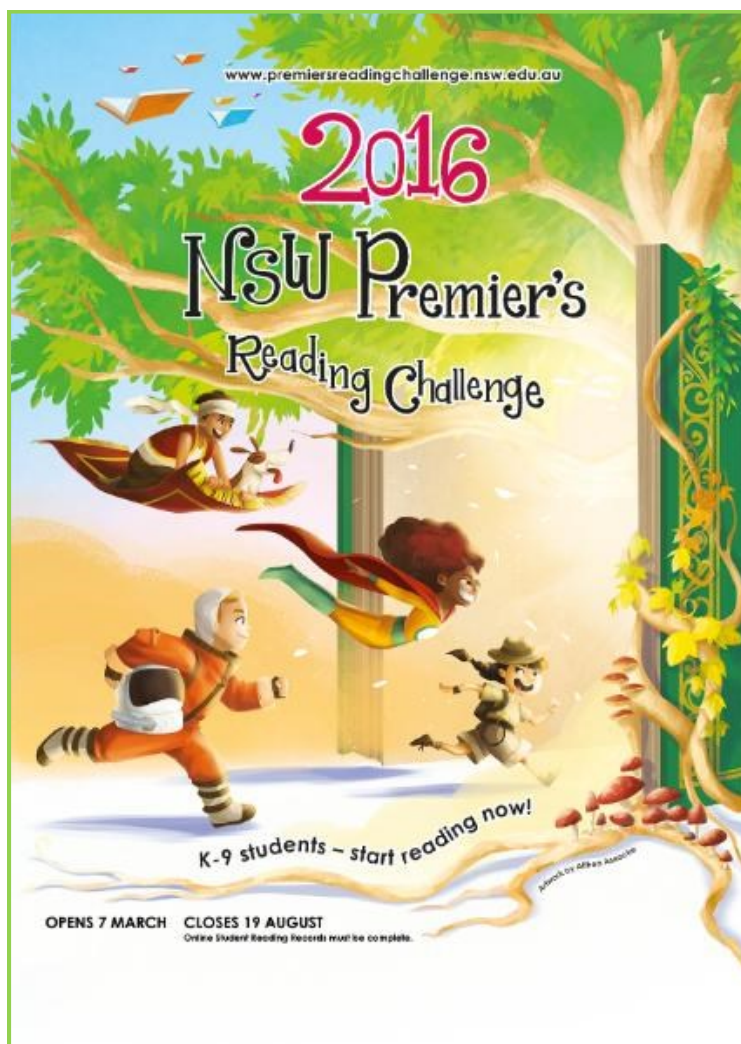
Sport
