There will be no borrowing from the school library for the next two weeks due to a system upgrade. Thanks!!

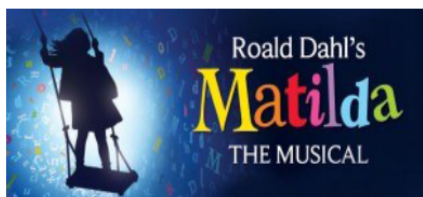
