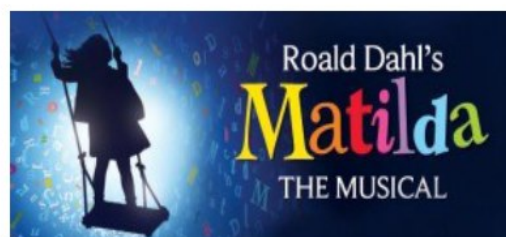
NUDE FOOD FRIDAY
