

Here we are in Term 4 already! We are not sure where the year has gone to but we are still very busy with our learning and we want to let you know what we have been doing so far this term.

Speaking & Listening has a new roster for the next 5 weeks and students took a copy home as well as the post on Seesaw. The class has become so confident in their public speaking and are very keen to have further opportunities next year, in a more competitive forum.

Gala is not far away and we are pretty happy with our dance. Thank you to all the families who have sent in their costumes. Luckily for us it is only a t-shirt for boys and the rest we can access from the costume room. Sunglasses are an optional item, but not compulsory. We hope you enjoy watching the dance in week 9..

Our class, with Year 3, have been maintaining contact with the residents of Henty Hospital, to keep them cheered up with reduced contact etc. We sent them cards earlier in the term and we received beautiful hand made cards back, which we enjoyed reading. See photos below.

Our Science unit this term is called *Living Things Change*, and the class are exploring the patterns of growth and change in living things, including making predictions about what they think will happen as things grow. We look for patterns and connections between species as well as differences.

Geography has a focus on *People and Places*, We have looked at why places have addresses, and the reason behind names of places and how those names were decided and given, this includes the cultural meaning behind many names and their importance.

Keeping yourself Safe is our PDH topic and we look at farm, beach, online and personal safety. Students identify the people and places that can help them keep safe, as well as how we help others keep safe.

Our text type is *Informative* and the class have been busy with Procedures. We shall finish that next week and commence on our *Narratives*, which will be Poetry, and we can't wait to start!

Numeracy covers a wide range of topics and students are keen to take on the challenges of the different areas within Maths. Our current focus of Multiplication & Division will take place for another week, combined with Time, so please take the opportunity to practise time with your child as it can be a difficult concept for students to master.


Our year 3 students have also been working very hard on perfecting their Gala dance. Everyone is very excited for dress rehearsals this week, before filming our performance.
